

Year 2 Unit 13 Extension Activity

We can read and write numbers up to 1000 in figures and in words

We can say and write numbers that have zero as a placeholder.

- As your child becomes more confident you can say a number, e.g. 153 and they write it down.
- Try 'tricky' sets of numbers that have similar digits and plenty of zero placeholders. e.g.
17, 107, 170, 1070, 71, 710, 701, 1700

This is a very challenging activity that needs a clear head!

If your child gets one wrong, repeat the number whilst they look at what they have written down so that they can check it.

If this does not help them to self-correct, ask them to read back the number they have written to you.

If they are still unsure or incorrect, write down the correct answer for them and ask them to read the digits back to you in words. Then compare what they wrote with the correct answer.

Whatever they wrote down will still be readable as a different number!
