

## Year 6 Unit 10c Activity Sheet Answers

We can multiply three-digit decimal numbers by a one-digit number using the grid method

Try these multiplications. It is helpful to estimate the answer first by rounding to the nearest whole number. This can then be used to check your answer after using the grid method.

$$3 \times 3.4 = 10.2$$

$$5 \times 3.45 = 17.25$$

$$7 \times 8.93 = 62.51$$

$$4 \times 2.99 = 11.96$$

$$6 \times 5.68 = 34.08$$

$$5 \times 9.99 = 49.95$$

$$4 \times 5.09 = 20.36$$

$$2 \times 0.93 = 1.86$$
