

Year 6 Unit 10c Extension Activity Answers

We can multiply three-digit decimal numbers by a one-digit number using the grid method

Try these. The grid method might not be needed for some of them.

$$4 \times 3.3 = 13.2$$

$$4 \times 3.33 = 13.32$$

$$4 \times 3.03 = 12.12$$

$$4 \times 0.33 = 1.32$$

$$4 \times 0.03 = 0.12$$

If we know that 5×2.2 is 11, can you write down some other multiplications with their answers?
